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# CIGIE Overview



- 73 Federal IGs, plus OMB, OSC, OPM, OGE
  - IGs are mix of auditors, lawyers, agents
  - Over 13,000 employees in IG community
  - Exec. Branch IGs, Leg. Branch IGs, Other Fed. IGs
  - Both Presidentially-Appointed IGs (PAS) and Agency-Appointment IGs (DFE)
- CIGIE Chair elected by IGs to 2 year term
- CIGIE Executive Chair is OMB Dep. Dir. of Management
- CIGIE has working groups and standing committees, including Audit Committee

# CIGIE Mission



Provided for in IG Act:

- Address integrity, economy, and effectiveness issues that transcend individual agencies
- Increase professionalism and effectiveness of personnel by developing policies, standards, and approaches to aid in establishment of well-trained and highly skilled OIG workforce.

# CIGIE Responsibilities



- Sets IG standards (audits, investigations, evaluations)
- Cross-cutting reviews/collaboration
- Professional development – IG training academies
- Integrity Committee – Reviews allegations of misconduct by IGs and other senior OIG officials
- Advocate/educate on issues of concern to IGs; outreach to stakeholders
- Facilitate providing of support and resources to IG community (e.g., shared services)
