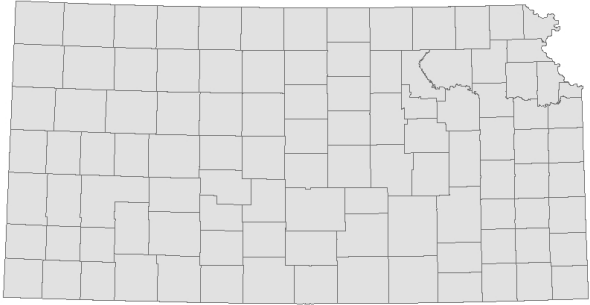


Reviewing Kansas's Procedures for Election Security, Part 2



Background:

- 105 Counties in Kansas
- County Election Officers oversee election processes
- Election workers perform frontline duties, including security procedures
- Elections in Kansas heavily rely on electronic voting and tabulation machines

We identified 55 best practices using the EAC's Election Management Guidelines and Kansas Statute, and we evaluated 13 counties policies and practices.



Overall Process Security:

Equipment is certified, inventoried, and tracked



Election Management Computer Security:

Computer is physically secured, access is logged, and internet is disconnected



Ballot Security:

Number and use of ballots are tracked



Voting and Tabulation Machine Security:

Machines are tested for accuracy and physically secured



Transfer and Movement Security:

Machines and results are sealed, tracked, and physically transferred

Why? : Large vs. Small counties
: State and county level guidance and training
